The 102nd Annual Convention of the Episcopal Diocese of Upper South Carolina was called to order on Friday November 8, 2024 at Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, Columbia by The Rt. Rev. Daniel P Richard, XI Bishop of Upper South Carolina. Along with nominations for positions on Standing Committee and the Disciplinary Board and proposed changes to our canons (i.e., bylaws), we welcomed three Missional congregations to Parish Status: St. Francis of Assisi, Chapin; Church of the Ridge, Edgefield, Trenton, Ride Spring; St. Bartholomew's, North Augusta.

Friday night, we watched a video on Hurricane Helene's destruction and how our diocese worked locally first and is making a commitment to Western North Carolina for assistance (Spruce Pine). We learned it will take years to fix things. Friday night's highlight was Bishop Daniel awarding two Cuthbert Crosses (the highest honor awarded in our diocese) to Frank Ballard (long-time diocesan staff member) and to The Rev. Deacon Mary Jeffers (Grace, Anderson).

Saturday, we started the day with the convention worship service. Then, the Bishop addressed the convention, calling for 2025 to be the Year of the Bible, asking everyone to read the Bible or at least the New Testament. The Bishop announced that our diocese was one of the few who experienced growth last year. He believes future growth will happen when we see an increase in Adult Baptism.

The 103rd Convention will be held Episcopal Church of the Advent Spartanburg SC, November 14-15. In closing I would like to thank the Vestry and St. Michael's allowing me to serve as a deputy to the 102nd Annual Convention.
